

Discipleship Devotional : Book of Hebrews

What's the purpose of a Discipleship Devotional?

This is a tool where an intentional process of discipleship between a leader and follower; mentor and mentee can take place.

This devotional process allows both to journey together (yet individually) through the Word of God, observing Biblical lessons and principles for personal spiritual growth. As well as uncovering tangible applications for the everyday real world journey.

How to journey through together?

- i. The leader/mentor will initiate a schedule most suitable for between themselves and the follower/mentee. Arriving at something consistent and realistic.
- ii. Both will go through a weekly (Monday to Friday) devotional process done with the chosen portion of scriptures. Saturday and Sunday are left to provide flexibility especially with weekend ministry.
- iii. At the end of the week (Friday) both are encouraged to make time to speak over the phone or video call - sharing their observations, applications and conclude by offering to pray for one another. Expect to have the conversations develop as this is when 'doing life' happens.
- iv. Journaling through this process is highly recommended. It's an immediate way to record down your thoughts and provides reference for future reflections. Use what's provided below or separate easy to locate journal (paperback or mobile app.)
- v. OPTIONAL : Leader/mentor can choose to meet on a monthly basis to physically follow up and pray for each other.

Why the book of : Hebrews?

- i. Hebrews is a great bridge between the Old and New Testament. It provides deeper perspective into past, present and future events.
- ii. Hebrews is unique that it reads like a sermon. Hence you will find that as you go through it, you may feel as though you have a preacher, teacher or coach right with you!
- iii. Hebrews provides believers with basic, intermediary and mature lessons and timeless principles for Christian living.
- iv. Through those variations it provides a platform for personal reflection, discussion, sharing of thoughts and encouragement to spur each other towards growth.
